### Have you heard of the **Healthy Start Scheme?**

If you are over ten weeks pregnant or have a child under the age of four, you may be entitled to help through the Healthy Start scheme.

If eligible, you will be sent a Healthy Start prepaid card for use in certain shops to buy:

- Milk
- Fruit and vegetables
- Pulses
- Infant formula based on cows milk

Your card can also be used to collect Healthy Start vitamins from any of our Family Hubs

### Medication...




If your child requires medication to be administered during club hours, you must complete a Medication Administration Consent Form for each medicine required. Copies of this form are available from our MSF office and clubs.

All medication should be delivered to our clubs in its original packaging, with a pharmacy label on it confirming who the medicine is for and the dose required (- this should match the information provided on the Medication Administration Consent Form). We are not permitted to administer the medication without this.

### Tapestry (children 5-11yrs)...

If your child attends our 5-11yrs clubs (Fort Royal or Poolbrook) and you would like to receive updates regarding their progress, please complete a copy of our Tapestry Consent Form (available from our MSF office – admin@malvernspecialfamilies.org.uk) and return this to us. We will then set up your child's online learning journal, where you can access photos of their experiences and achievements at our clubs.
